Fernwaters is a grade 4-8 school. Therefore, we do not have data on graduation rates, SAT scores, or IRI. Due to the public health emergency, we do not have Spring 2020 ISAT data. We do have DIBELS data from February 2020. At that time, 67% of 6th grade students were at or above reading benchmarks, and 75% of 7th grade students were at or above reading benchmarks. However, only 29% of 8th grade students were at reading benchmarks. The 2019-2020 8th grade cohort was a small group of students (7) and 3 of them were receiving interventions for reading. Although we fell below this benchmark, we are comfortable maintaining our goal of 65% proficiency. DIBELS math scores show 100% of 7th & 8th graders between 40-90 percentile, and 92% of 6th graders in that range. Based on that data, we believe were on track to meet our academic goals.
